

Security Safety Meeting

Tenant involvement throughout City Center is critical in supporting the life safety program. Effective communication with Security when a situation or concern arises is vital. Reporting suspicious individuals, deliveries and occurrences will assist Security in its prevention endeavors. It is equally important to familiarize yourself with the life safety features of the buildings. Making yourself aware of the sights and sounds related to the emergency systems will give the confidence needed in an emergency situation such as a fire alarm or weather-related event.

City Center Security provides tenant life safety training on an annual basis to enhance the tenant's awareness and knowledge of life safety procedures and systems in the buildings. Additional training is offered to tenants upon request.

Because of Covid precautions in recent years, the training has been delayed. However, we are pleased to share that this Spring, the Security team will once again be hosting this meeting for tower tenants.
