### JOIN US ON SEPT 9!

Many people have asked if they could come watch the Memorial Tower Climb and the answer is a resounding **YES**! The purpose of the event overall is to memorialize the Fallen Heroes from 9/11 and to continue remembering and honoring them today.

During the City Center climb, participants will climb or walk 36 floors, 3 times in the Bank of America Tower at 301 Commerce Street, which is nearly the equivalent of the 110 stories of the World Trade Center.

There will be various tributes to memorialize the fallen first responders including a local pipe & drum band playing *Amazing Grace*, a dedicated moment of silence recognizing the timeline that unfolded on September 11, 2001, and each of today's heroes – our local first responders – will carry a name and photo of a hero who responded to the World Trade Centers.


All participants in this tower climb are area first responders. Many are firefighters wearing an additional fifty to seventy pounds of their protective gear and firefighting equipment and officers wearing an additional ten to thirty pounds of their bullet proof vest and duty service belt.
