At a recent visit by the Alveole beekeeper, she gave the hive a refill of sugar syrup and a pollen patty that they absolutely loved! In fact, they enjoyed it so much that a worker bee was seen with its tongue fully extended, using it as a straw to slurp up the sugar syrup that dripped.



Un-bee-lievable Facts!

Did you know that bumblebees get to take home the award for having the longest tongue of all the bees? It may not look like it when their tongue is fully extended, but bee's tongues have multiple joints that allow their tongue to fold inside their mouth like the pleats of an accordion. The tongue length determines how far a bee can reach inside a flower to get nectar.



Did you know that even bees need to earn their stripes? Bumble bees hatch with pale, almost white hairs. It takes a couple of days for them to develop their signature yellow stripes. Kind of like how honey bees hatch with paler colors!
