Texans need blood donations now. As the community blood center for North, Central and East Texas, the impact your donation makes could be closer than you think. It helps our neighbors like Hunter from Fort Worth. In March 2023, 20-year-old Hunter had a heart attack and soon after, he and his family found out his kidneys failed. But because of blood donors, Hunter was able to quickly start the lifesaving treatment he needed. Hunter's mom shares her gratitude for the donors that provided blood needed for his two transfusions and emphasizes the impact blood donations can make. She shares this important reminder, "An hour of your time can save the lives of three people."


