

2024 Total Solar Eclipse

For an alternative viewing option, feel free to bring your own Indirect Solar Viewing objects, such as a pasta colander, spoon with holes in it, or an index card or paper plate with a hole punched in it!

If you plan to stay a while to view the full solar progression, please consider wearing sunscreen or protective clothing to prevent sunburns. There will be no tents or structures for shade.
