-Dinner & Bar Service: Starting at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday-Saturday

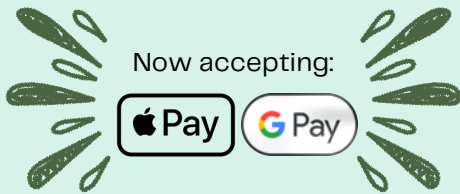
Seating is limited, and reservations are highly recommended.

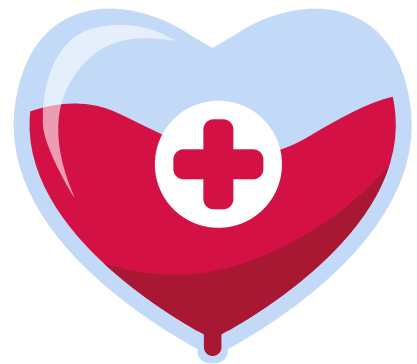
As you may have noticed, there have been many changes recently in the Parking Department. Effective January 1, 2026, parking is no longer free during nights and weekends due to the expiration of the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) agreement provided by the City of Fort Worth in previous years. As a result, standard parking rates will now apply at all times. In addition, all parking rates (including daily & monthly parkers) will now be subject to applicable state taxes, which will be added to the posted parking fees. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as these changes take effect.
