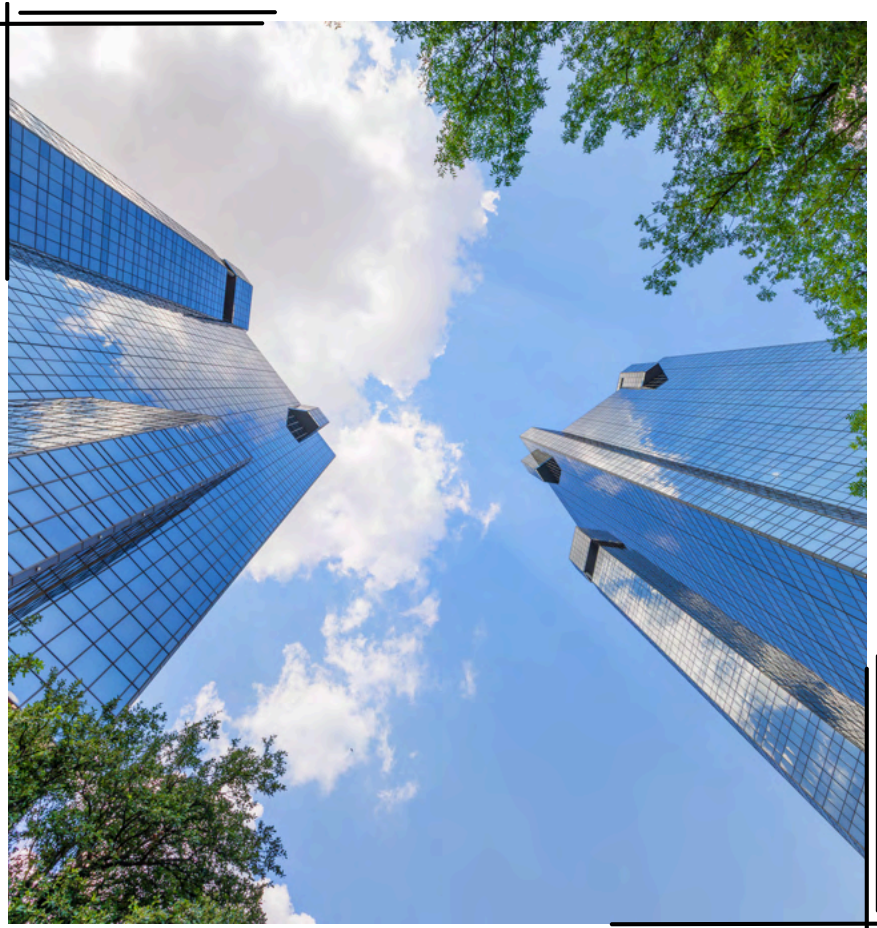

TURNSTILES

We have received a few additional questions about the turnstiles since the last newsletter went out and we would like to share the questions & answers with everyone now too.

Where will the turnstiles be located?

In each tower, there will be turnstiles at the elevator bank entrances. The Wells Fargo Tower will have two entrance/exit points, one on the south end and one at the east entrance. The Bank of America Tower will have four entrance/exit points, one at each entry point to all elevators. Each entrance/exit point will have more than one turnstile to help with traffic flow and ease of access.

What will the turnstiles look like?

This photo is an example from the manufacturer's website, but it's a good sample of what our turnstiles will look like once they're onsite in the City Center lobbies.



How many people from our office can have access to provide QR codes to our guests?

Each company would need to determine who should have this type of control from their office. There is no limit per tenant, but please be prudent when deciding who would be able to provide access to outside guests. **NOTE:** The QR codes should not be handed out to delivery drivers of any kind. Please use the food lockers for food deliveries or meet the delivery person at street level to retrieve your order(s).

When will the turnstiles be installed & active?

The Wells Fargo Tower turnstiles will be installed beginning on April 30 - May 3.
The Bank of America Tower turnstiles will be installed May 14 - 17.

Please Note:

- The installation will mainly take place at night during the week or over the weekend so there should be little to no disruption to office tenants.
- Once the turnstiles are installed, there will be a grace period where we're all getting used to the new devices - both our teams and tenants alike. During this time, the turnstiles will be in place, but will not be "active". We will use this time to confirm badge access is working for all tenants passing through or troubleshoot as needed too.
- As with any new product installation, all dates are subject to change. We will keep everyone updated should these anticipated dates need to be modified.
